

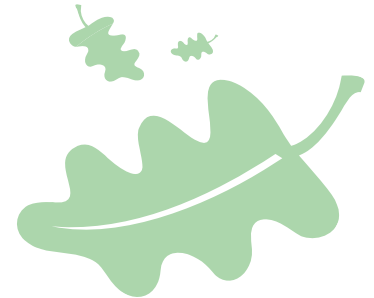

Senior Center

8235 Mt. Vernon Street

This beautiful facility features large French doors opening onto a spacious patio surrounded by grassy areas and walkways creating its own private park-like setting. The large fully equipped kitchen is designed to handle all of your catering needs. The Senior Center adjoins Lemon Grove Park and is the perfect location for an outdoor wedding followed by an indoor reception. The facility seats up to 200 for banquet style events, and up to 300 for theater style events.

Community Center

3146 School Lane

The Lemon Grove Community Center is conveniently located in the heart of Lemon Grove. The Community Center features a full kitchen and all the amenities for smaller meetings, conferences, and private parties. The Community Center seats up to 75 for banquet style events, and up to 100 for theater style events.

H. Lee House Courtyard

3225 Olive Street

This intimate outdoor courtyard sits next to the historical H. Lee House. It features a beautiful gazebo for ceremonies or entertainment surrounded by inlaid brickwork and grass. The H. Lee House Courtyard is the perfect setting for an outdoor wedding, anniversary party, and many other special occasion events. The capacity is approximately 100.

Parks

Lemon Grove Park, 2259 Washington Street

Six acres—playground, gazebo, picnic areas and tables, restrooms, basketball court, and walking path.

Berry Street Park, 7071 Mt. Vernon Street

Six acres—playground, gazebos, picnic areas and tables, restrooms, and walking path.

Dan Kunkel Park, 8105 Lemon Grove Way

One acre, neighborhood park with playground, picnic area and tables, basketball court, and walking path.

Firefighter's Park, 3062 School Lane

Home of the "Skate Spot," this park also has benches and an open grass area.

Civic Center Park, 3200 Main Street

Neighborhood park adjacent to the H. Lee House and Parsonage Museum. No amenities.
